

Newsletter Spain – September 2020

Ultimately, 2 million hl of the 3.2 million hl requested by the wine sector were distilled in Spain. Of this, 1.5 million hl were table wine at a price of \in 25.00 / hl and 0.5 million hl were IGP / DO wine at a price of \in 35.00 / hl. This quantity was enough for the producers to be able to sell wines of inferior quality, and even if the remaining amount of 1.2 million hl seems large at first glance, it is distributed among many different producers.

In general, this new crop is expected to be very good in 2020:

• In France the total harvest will be around 45 million HL (+ 6% from 2019) - there would be stocks from previous harvests but most of them would be AOP wines.

• In Italy around 55 million HL (after a normal harvest of 48 million HL in 2019). A large harvest is generally expected in all production areas, with min. + 15% than a normal harvest. There has been heavy rainfall in the north in the past few days which could potentially affect the condition of the grapes, but you have to wait for the harvest to see any damage.

• In Spain we expect a harvest of 45 to 47 million HL (38 million HL in 2019), including 23 million HL in LA MANCHA.

• Chile - Total wine production for 2020 is 10 million HL or -13% from last year. The current price of red wine 12% (FOB Valparaiso) - 45.00 - 65.00 USD / HL

• In Argentina, the total wine production for 2020 is also around 10 million hectoliter or -20% compared to the previous year. In addition, 4,430.000 hl of must were produced, which corresponds to a stock of around 160,000 tons of must concentrate, which makes Argentina the world's leading exporter of this product.

The current price for red wine 12% (FCA Mendoza) - 28.00 - 30.00 USD / hl., which corresponds to a price FOB Valparaiso of 36.00 - 38.00 USD / hl (without Flexitank).

Of course, it is still too early to give the starting prices for the new 2020 harvest in Spain. In view of the development of the vines, the Airén harvest should start around September 15, 2020. As every year, the price of the Airén sets prices in Spain for all other grape varieties because of its large production volume. If the vines develop their normal course, we should expect the starting prices listed below, which are very similar to the market situation of the 2014/2015 harvest.

As mentioned in our last market report, the starting prices of the harvest could be what we suggested:

• White wine FT (traditionally fermented), starting price around € 2.30 / h°.

- White wine FC (controlled fermentation), around € 2.40 / h°.
- Rosé wine FT (traditionally fermented), starting price around € 2.40 / hº.
- Rosé wine FC (controlled fermentation), around € 2.50 / h°.

• Red wine between 11% and 12%, color 4-5 points, starting price between € 2.60 and € 2.70 / h^o

• Red wine between 12.5% and 14.9% vol., color 8-9 points between € 2.70 and € 3.10 / h^o

Depending on the confirmation of the wineries, the prices for the first wines (already harvested grapes) with grape variety crop 2020 are as follows:

WHITE WINE / VARIETIES

- Chardonnay, around € 4.00 h°
- Sauvignon Blanc, around € 4.00 h°
- Verdejo, around € 3.50 h°
- Muscat / Moscatel, around € 3.00 h^o
- Macabeo, around € 2.60 h^o
- Airén -> from 10/15 September 2020

RED WINE / VARIETIES

- Merlot, around € 4.20 h°
- Cabernet Sauvignon, around € 3.90 h°
- Syrah, around € 3.50 h°
- Tempranillo -> from 7 September 2020

GRAPE JUICE CONCENTRATE /RECTIFIED GRAPE JUICE CONCENTRATE – on the base of price of must from crop 2020

We are assuming that there will be around 2 million HL of sulphurized must (not concentrated) on the market. This means that the price for de-ionized, rectified grape juice concentrate should be very competitive in the next campaign. Currently we can offer:

- Rectified grape must concentrate (de-ionised) 65 Brix approx. € 1.15 / kg
- White grape must concentrate 65 Brix approx. €uro 1.00 / kg
- Red grape must concentrate 65 Brix, T500 approx. €uro 1.25 / kg

For your projects for organic wines with EU certification - ECOSHERT / SOHISCERT - we would like to know your request. It is important to know that due to the ideal weather conditions in Spain, there is no problem for vineyards to fulfil the standards for certification. More and more cooperatives are offering large quantities of organic wines at very interesting prices.

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
