

## Newsletter Spain - September 2021

The harvest has just started with the harvest of the white grape varieties Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc.

Due to the intense heat waves in Spain in August, the yields of these varietal wines have fallen sharply, between -20% and -30% compared to the volume of the 2020 harvest and, as a result, there is a price increase of + 50%. The Airén harvest begins around September 15th, it is the most widely grown grape variety in La Mancha and has the greatest impact on the rest of the market prices.

The "harvest scenario 2021" shows a very significant loss of volume in Europe, taking into account that the stocks in Spain which are for sale have been very low since April 2021. While there was still talk of a crisis distillation in spring 2021, this idea was completely discarded from the end of April 2021, when stocks began to decline. Since May / June 2021 and until today, the demand for Spanish wine has been and will continue to be very strong. The most important consequence is that producers will not lower their prices in the short term.

According to estimates by the Spanish Wine Market Observatory (OEMV) and the Semana Vitivinicola (SEVI)

- Spain expects a maximum of 38 million hl (47 million in 2020), of which +/ 19 million in the La Mancha region (25 million in 2020)
- France forecasts a harvest of +/- 33 million hl (45/47 million in 2020)
- Italy forecasts a harvest of +/- 44 million hl (55 million in 2020)

In summary, we expect a harvest in Europe that is 30 million hectoliters smaller than that of the previous year.

What is certain is that Spanish growers start the harvest with very little stocks available for sale. We have been feeling this since April / May, when it became difficult to find large volumes for new contracts. Only contracts with shipments before the end of August and the 2021 harvest were concluded. With the severe frost damage in France and Italy, the very low wine prices rose steadily.

Will this situation last for a long time? On a commercial level, the offered prices in the past few weeks seemed high and we believed they would not hold up. However, the development of the market and the enormous activity that we have had since the beginning of the harvest suggest that the prices will be accepted by the various markets. In fact, since the publication of the first prices of the Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc fresh grape must campaign since August 16, 2021, and the conclusion of the first contracts, we have noticed that prices will continue to rise for at least a few weeks.

- By the end of August the big French and German sparkling wine producers already have contracted considerable quantities of base wine for sparkling, white 10% vol.. FC for € 33.00 / HL. Today nobody sells basic sparkling wine for less than 35,00/36,00 / hl. This wine category is always the first to open the campaign and serves as a barometer to see if prices are accepted by the market.
- Fresh Moscatel must, which in recent years has generally cost between € 3.00 / hº and € 4.00 / hº, currently costs from € 5.00 / h and is mainly sold to Italy. Apparently, Italy has suffered from the frost and less moscatel harvest is expected this year.
- Almost similar situation for Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, for the French market, where must is sold between 7.50 °Be and 9.00 °Be. At this starting price level, the wine prices would also rise after vinification.
- As we know, generic wines are not as "limited" in stock as varietal wines. For this reason, we are still of the opinion that the prices for "generic wines" should not rise as much as for varietal wines. But the current circumstances lead us to assume that the prices already offered are consistent and, above all, will not decrease in the short term.

To date it is a very uncertain situation with enormous nervousness among buyers as well as producers, and it is not foreseeable whether the buying trend will follow the

price trend. We will closely follow the market development in the coming weeks and keep you up to date as usual.

The contracts are currently being signed "with reservation of samples", ie the quantity is reserved, the quality is subject to profile / tank validation after vinification, since the wines of the new harvest will not be available in mid-November 2021 suggested below to be guaranteed.

THE PRICES ABOVE have to be multiplicated with the requested alcohol degree, then we get the price €/HL

i.e. \*-> € 3,50 h° x 12% = EUROS 42,50/HL EXW
